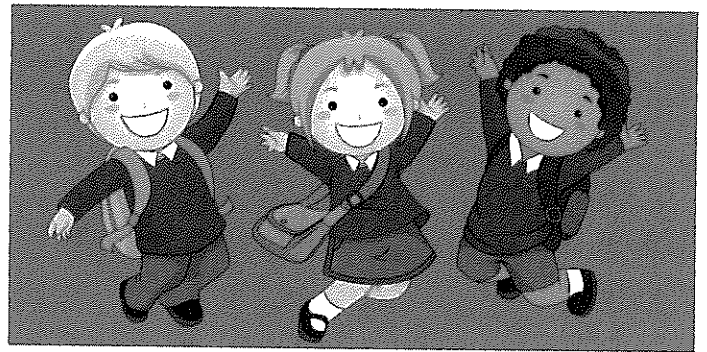

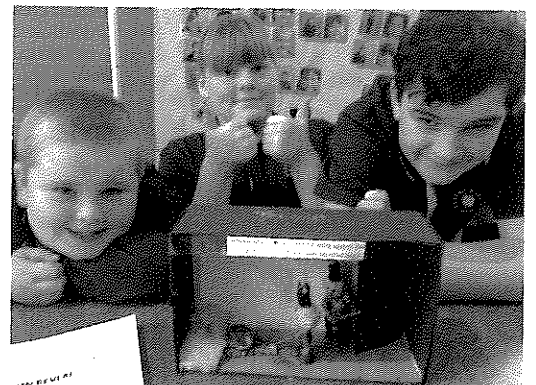
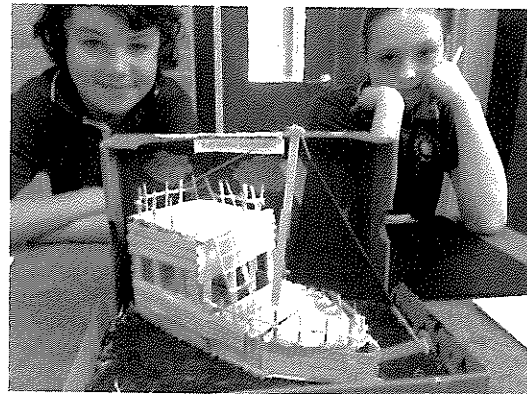
2ND HAND UNIFORM

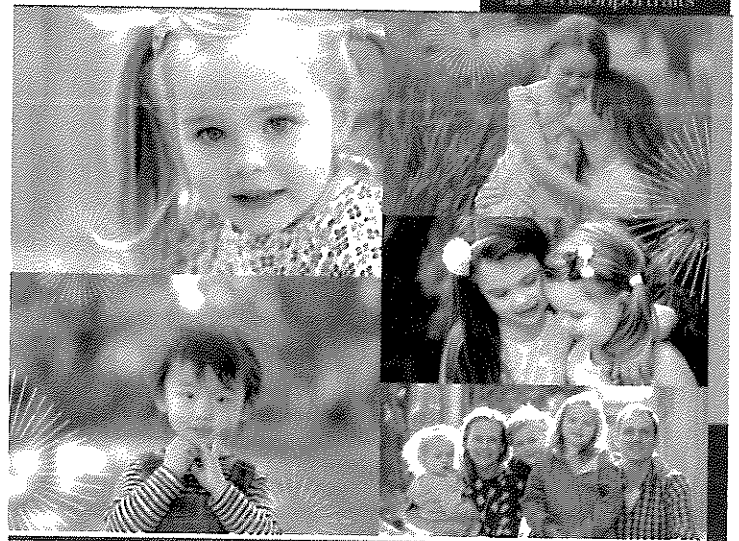

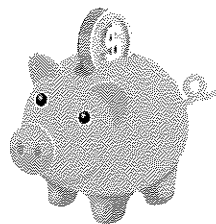

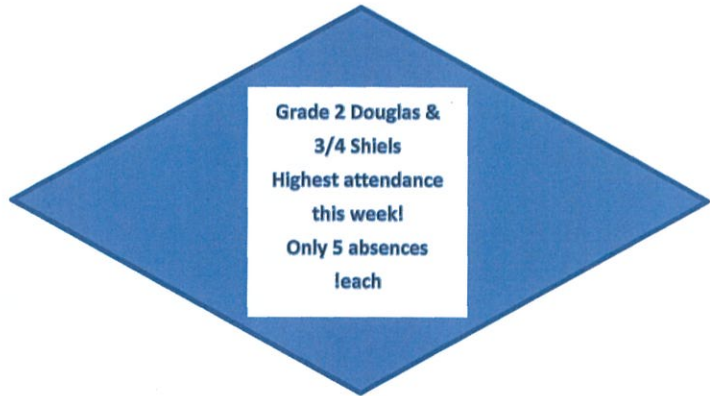
