Whole School Swimming Fun Day—13th Dec

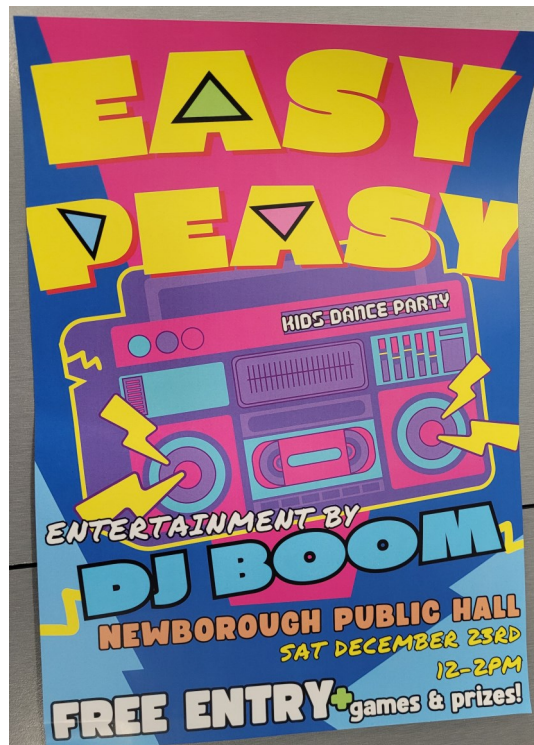

ART

Each week in art children get inspired, learn something new, practise their artmaking skills and then create a final artwork.

Students from Mr Burnett's class chose one of their final artworks to exhibit at assembly. In term 1 the year 2/3's got inspired by Pablo Picasso, learnt about abstract art and practised creating portraits. In term 2 students got inspired by Henri Rousseau, learnt about creating foreground and background and then practised collaging a tiger. In term 3 they got inspired by monsters, learnt about creating balance and symmetry and then practised screen printing and sewing a symmetrical monster. In term 4 students got inspired by fish, learnt about texture and practised jelly-plate printing stencil fish after making their own fish scale stamps. The artwork was amazing and the students were proud of their creations.



On Thursday 6th December the Junior School Council were successful in campaigning for a bench seat to be located just outside the school gate and the ribbon was officially cut!
