As required by our OH&S policy a kind reminder that if you are picking your child up early they must be signed out at the office kiosk. Our office staff are happy to help if you need assistance.



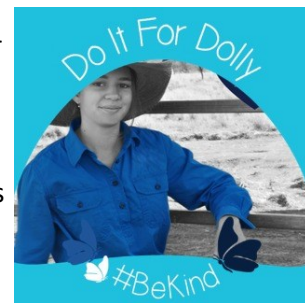
Working Bee Reminder

Sentral—Absences

Spare Clothes

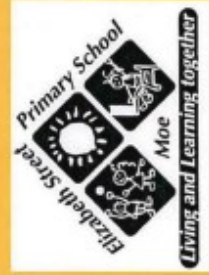
