On Saturday 14th October the

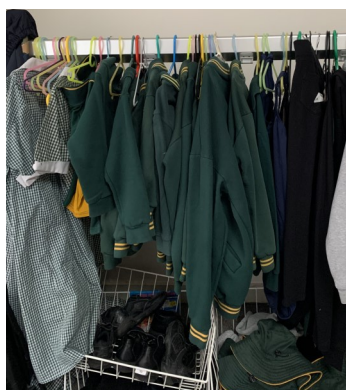
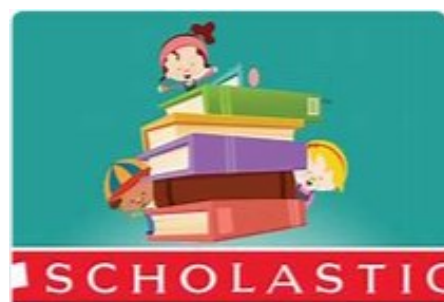
referendum voting will be held

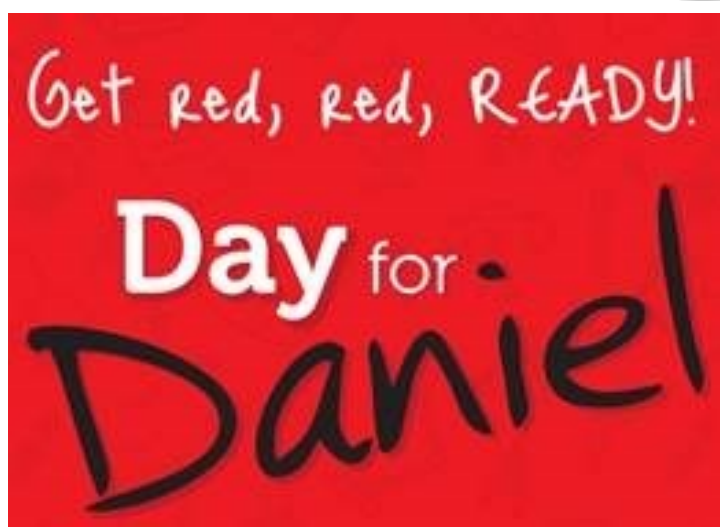
