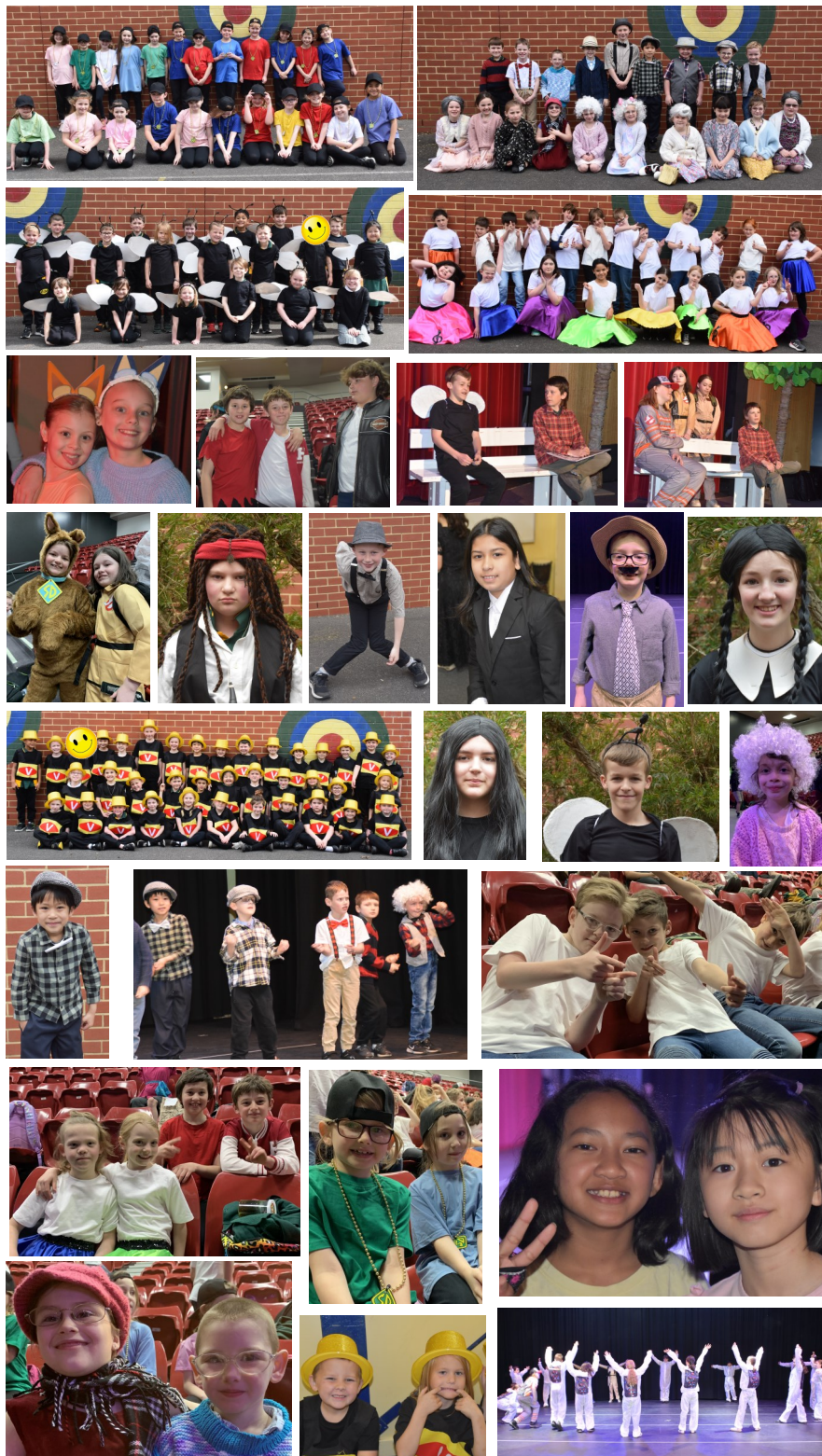

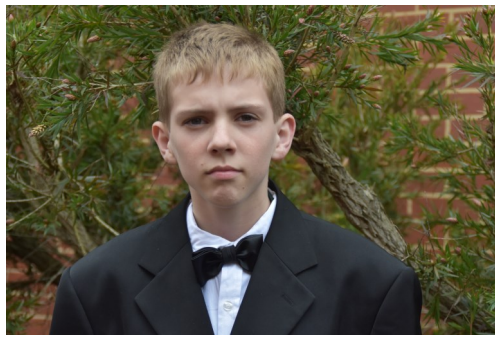
SCHOOL CONCERT

Sentral—Absences
